Payment for each activity/event can be made in installments. Payment must be made in cash or money order. **No personal checks will be accepted.** Since the cost of the activities is based on a specific number of students, if you need to cancel for any reason, refunds will be made up to one month prior to the activity date (exception: no refunds can be made for the graduation gown, t-shirt, class photo, and ice cream social).

Like all field trips, these 8th grade activities are a privilege. Eligibility for these activities is based upon administrative approval for each 8th grade student. Disciplinary infractions can result in one or all 8th grade activities being forfeited, with the exception of the promotion ceremony. As detailed in our Parent-Student Handbook, no advance notice to parents/guardians or students is necessary to revoke these privileges, as the handbook serves as notice.

Finally, the cost of a yearbook and a class ring have always been separate from 8th grade dues. Information about purchasing these additional 8th-grade only items will be provided at a later date.
