SUMMER UPDATES AND REMINDERS

1. **Student Schedules - Update**
 - a. Student schedules are available in the Genesis parent portal starting August 2, 2018 at 12 noon. Student schedules will be mailed home on August 6, 2018.
 - b. Schedule change requests from parents/guardians will be received on August 13 and 14, 2018 only. Parents/Guardians should complete the schedule change request form online (hard copies are available in the main office as well) and submit them via email or to the main office on August 13 or 14, 2018. Requests will be reviewed by the Principal and parents/guardians will be contacted with a decision before the summer is over
2. **Parent-Student Handbook - Update**
 - a. Our updated Parent-Student Handbook for the 2018-2019 school year is available on our website starting August 2, 2018.
 - b. Copies will be distributed at our Meet and Greet/Parent Orientation sessions as well.

 - a. All incoming 7th graders and all rising 8th graders are responsible for this summer work for reading AND math.
 - b. All assignments (reading AND math) are due September 14, 2018 and will count as a quiz grade. No late work will be accepted.
6. **Student Uniform Changes**
 - a. Please see pages 37-38 of our Parent-Student Handbook for our UPDATED uniform policy. It is different from previous years.
 - b. Unlike in years past, students are allowed to wear their gym uniform ONLY on gym days. Students must wear proper school uniforms on the days they do not have gym. Also unlike in years past, students are NOT allowed to wear jeans, pants that have jean-like material, jeggings, leggings, or the like.
